








PELJEŠAC


KORČULA







Elegance, history, and bliss – the essence of the Mediterranean.



Did you know that...

- The world-famous **Dalmatian dog breed** originates from this region! Though the exact origins are debated, the breed has been depicted in ancient Dalmatian artwork and was historically used as a carriage dog by nobility.
- You might not know this, but the world-famous Zinfandel grape, actually traces its roots back to Dalmatia, where it's known as **Crljenak Kaštelanski** or **Tribidrag**, you might have been sipping on Dalmatian vines for years – you just didn't know it.
- The Adriatic along the Dalmatian coast is incredibly clear – you can often see all the way to the bottom, even several meters deep. Perfect for diving, snorkeling, or just staring into the blue and questioning life. **It's one of the cleanest seas in Europe**
- The phrase “Dalmatian islands” covers a lot of ground - literally. There are 698 islands, 389 islets and 78 reefs along the entire Croatian coast in total, including two national parks: the **Kornati archipelago** and **Mljet** - the “green island”



DALMATIAN CUISINE

Dalmatian cuisine is a perfect reflection of its coastal and island lifestyle—fresh, light, and infused with Mediterranean flavors. Locally sourced seafood, aromatic olive oils, and fragrant herbs form the foundation of many traditional dishes. Must-try specialties include:



Peka

A slow-cooked dish of meat (often lamb, veal, or octopus) and vegetables, baked under an iron bell.



Pašticada

A rich, slow-cooked beef stew marinated in wine and spices, served with homemade gnocchi.



Black Risotto (Crni Rižot)

A flavorful squid-ink risotto, popular along the coast.
